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P1801 Working Group

- Jointly sponsored by
 - IEEE Standards Association Corporate Advisory Group
 - IEEE Design Automation Standards Committee (DASC)
- Approved by IEEE
 - NesCom on May 8, 2007
 - Standards Board on May 9, 2007
- Entity-based – One vote per company
- Current Chair – Stephen Bailey



P1801 Working Group Status

- Participation
 - Open to everyone
 - 20 organizations - including major end-user and EDA companies
- Policies and procedures
 - Established and approved on June 1, 2007
- Scope
 - Underway and approaching completion
- Technology donation window
 - open until June 15th



P1801 Roadmap

- Target completion in <1 year
- Key steps
 - Request for technology – DONE
 - Complete P&Ps – DONE
 - Ratify scope – June 7, 2007
 - Set up bug-tracking system – June 30, 2007
 - Refine donations – November 30, 2007
 - Draft – December 31, 2007
 - Balloting – January-March, 2008
